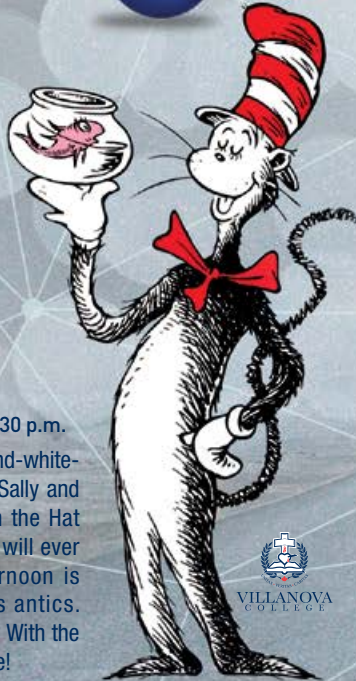

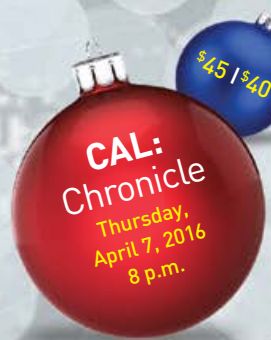

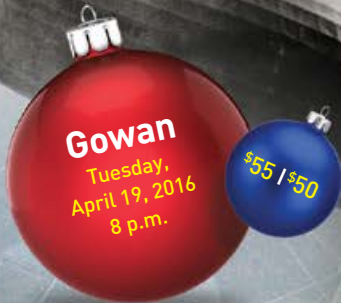
Note for Note. Cut for Cut.
